GOSPELS

4 accounts of Jesus life story

Matthew Written to Jews

Mark Written to Romans

Luke Written to Gentiles (non Jews)

John Written to everyone



ACTS

Historical record of the beginning of the church

- 1. Holy Spirit comes after Jesus Death**
- 2. Apostles call for Baptism and repentance**
- 3. Appoint more leaders and grow disciples**
- 4. Persecuted for preaching Jesus resurrection**
- 5. Saul converts after persecuting new Christians and becomes Paul, the church's biggest missionary**

Paul's letters to churches

1 & 2 Thessalonians – encouraging a church

1 Corinthians – problems & questions of the church

Galatians – explanation of Christian beliefs

2 Corinthians – on reconciliation & false teachers

Romans – God's gift of salvation offered to all

Ephesians – wisdom and advice for Christians

Philippians – finding joy in all circumstances

Colossians - Christ Jesus feeds us



Paul's letters to specific people

Philemon – writing on behalf of a friend in prison to owner of slave

1 Timothy – advice on how to be a minister

Titus – advice on leadership

2 Timothy – asking Timothy to visit him in prison

Other letters

James – Advice to new Christians

Hebrews – Jesus authority & purpose (writer unknown)

1 & 2 Peter – Letters to Jewish Christians from apostle Peter

Jude – warning about false teachers

1,2,3 John letters to Christians from John

Revelations – prophecy from John about the end of time
